I hereby certify that ever horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the Constitution and Rules of Equine Canada at this competition. It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I herby accept this risk and hold harmless EC, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees and their representatives.

For the purpose of these Rules, the person Responsible is normally the trainer, owner or the competitor who rides or drives the horse during an event, or a parent or legal guardian in the case of junior competitors. The Person Responsible is ultimately responsible for the condition, fitness and management of the horse and is alone responsible for any act performed in the stables by himself or herself or be an other person with authorized access to the horse, or while the horse is being ridden, driven or exercises. Parents and guardians are entitled to sign their children's entry forms without being EC members or holder of a sport licence, provided they agree to abide by the rules and penalties contained in the Rule Book (A213.2).
